

# Interested in Becoming Catholic, or refreshing your memory?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) has begun. We are currently in the inquiry phase. It's culmination is

the inquirer's decision to enter the catechumenate, the period of formal preparation for entrance into full membership in the Catholic Church. This phase may last a few weeks. If anyone is still thinking about becoming catholic, or is still on the fence about that decision, it is not too late. Just come to our next session and check it out for yourself. The next session will be on Monday, November 9th at 7 pm in the rectory.



Our Religious Education program is going virtual. *Faith Alive!* provides access to all of our regular curriculum as well as additional activities and formation opportunities for the entire family.

Virtual learning is underway. Contact the parish office to register your child, ask questions, or volunteer.

A \$500 grant received from the Diocese of Scranton covers the full cost of the virtual platform as well as about 50% of the curriculum expense for this year.
