

Local pantries are in great need due to the pandemic and are extremely grateful for your continuing generous support. Donations of nonperishable food




items, paper products, personal hygiene items, or gift cards to local stores are greatly appreciated.

THE TRIDUUM

The Journey of Our Redemption
The Paschal Triduum (TRID-oo-um), Latin for
"three days," commemorates Christ's redemptive journey through death, burial and resurrection to new life.
The Church observes the Triduum as a single event made
up of three distinct parts:

HOLY THURSDAY

The first day of the Triduum is filled with the action of Christ's self-gift. The Mass of the Lord's Supper on the evening of **Holy Thursday** commemorates Christ's command that we "love one another." Symbolized in the washing of the feet, the great commission of Christ is made concrete in the Eucharist as well as in Jesus' crucifixion on Calvary. The liturgy ends with a procession as consecrated hosts are set aside for Holy Communion on Good Friday.

GOOD FRIDAY

Although no Mass is celebrated on Good Friday, the liturgical celebration concentrates on the reading of the passion story from John's Gospel, the veneration of the cross by the assembly, and the reception of Holy Communion from the hosts that were consecrated on Holy Thursday.

Easter Vigil

Today is filled with the silence of the tomb as the faithful deepen their understanding of the meaning of Jesus' death and prepare for the Easter Vigil in the evening which officially begins the Easter celebration. **The Easter Vigil** is the high point of the liturgical year. The
