until 7 pm, St. Michael's Church

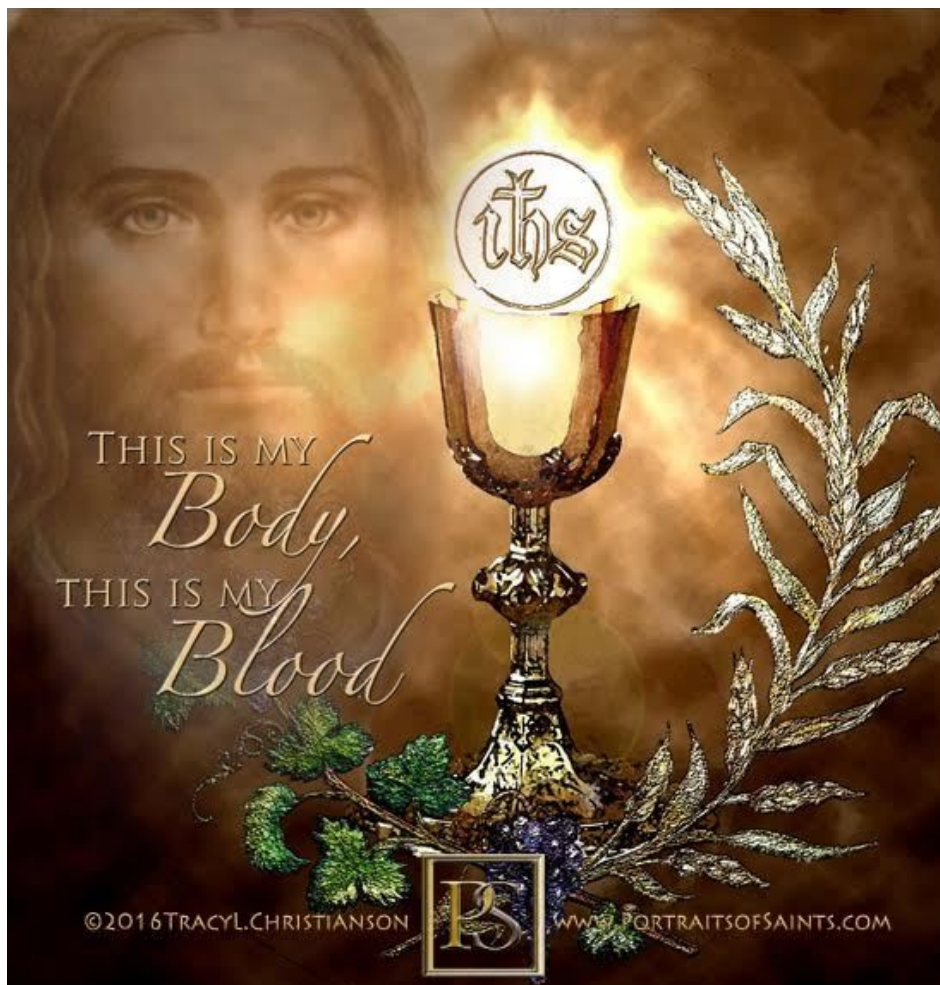

## FATHER ED MICHELINI TO BE HONORED

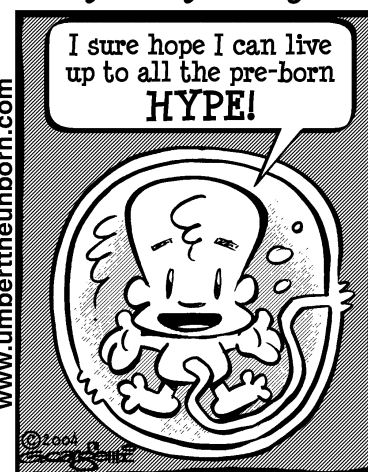
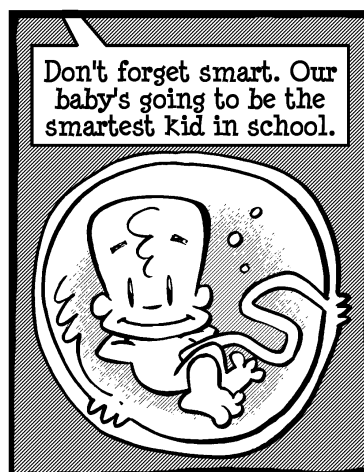
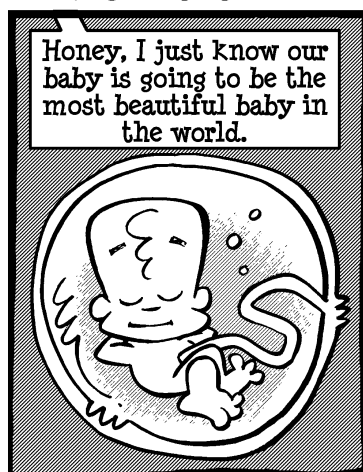
