
### **KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS**

This Sunday, August 14th, at the 9:30 am Mass, the Knights of Columbus is offering the Mass intention for the Canonization of Blessed Father Michael McGivney. A Rosary and Litany of Blessed Father Michael



Rosary and Litany of Blessed Father Michael McGivney begins at 8:45 am led by the Knights of Columbus.

Michael McGivney was born August 12, 1852. He was Ordained December 22, 1877. He founded the Knights of Columbus in 1882. He died August 14, 1890 at the age of 38 after serving in the Priesthood for 13 years. He was



declared Venerable on March 15, 2008. A miracle was approved for his Beatification on May 27, 2020. Venerable Father Michael McGivney was beatified on October 31, 2020. His Feast Day is established as August 13th.

In observance of Suicide Awareness Month, Bishop Bambera will celebrate a **MASS FOR SU-ICIDE HEALING AND REMEMBRANCE**. The Mass will serve to remember loved ones lost to suicide, and to promote healing for those who grieve their passing.

**WATCH** In the Gospels we hear Jesus refer to his mother Mary as "Woman." This reference should draw our attention to both Genesis and Revelation. But





THE BIBLE and the VIRGIN MARY JOURNEY THROUGH SCRIPTURE


This episode also reveals how John's Apocalyptic visions are the dramatic fulfillment of the promise God made back in the Garden of Eden!
