


BRADFORD COUNTY PENNSYLVANIANS FOR HUMAN LIFE CALLING VOLUNTEERS FOR LIFE

How Do I Offer a Mass for Someone?

It's easy! Call or email the parish office, or send a letter through the offertory basket or the carrier of your choice. Include the name of the person for whom the Mass will be offered, the name of the person requesting the Mass (ie - Peter Piper; Mr. & Mrs. Smith; Larry, Moe and Curly Stooge; The Partridge Family, etc. - just keep it reasonably short). If you would like a card sent to either the living person or the family of the deceased person for whom you are offering Mass, be sure to include their name and complete address. The Mass card will include the date, time and location of the Mass as scheduled. Please note-this is not a guarantee. Masses rarely need to be re-scheduled, but it can happen. Check the bulletin for that week to make sure there has not been a change, especially if you are travelling a long distance.

Mass can be offered for *anyone*, living or deceased. It doesn't matter if they are Catholic, Protestant, a non-Christian religion or no religion at all.

The usual offering for a Mass is \$10, which is paid to the priest who celebrates the Mass, usually at the end of each month. If you choose to send your Mass offering through the collection basket, please mark it clearly as a Mass offering or it may be deposited into the Operating Account as a weekly offering. A separate check, payable to St. Michael Parish, is preferred to make sure it is deposited correctly.
