### WELCOME, REVEREND TONY MATHEW

Heralds of Good News is a Missionary Society of Apostolic Life. Founded in Eluru diocese, India on October 14, 1984; it became an Institute of Pontifical Right on May 5, 1999. The specific aim of the Society is the promotion of vocations to priesthood, the training of seminarians and the supply of zealous and hardworking missionaries to the dioceses in India and abroad which experience a shortage of priests due to the lack of local vocations. Currently, the Order is blessed with 502 priests and 150 seminarians studying at various levels of formation, and Mother Theresa Province (one of the 5 Provinces) is blessed with 71 priests 55 Seminarians.

Priests from this order have been serving in this diocese since 2018 and are serving in 10 Mission dioceses in India as well as Australia, Canada, Italy, and United States of America. The Mission motto of our Province is "To live our call as Herald with apostolic availability, adaptability, and openness, relying on divine providence and the intercession of our Heavenly Patrons and in imitation of St. Theresa of Kolkata's Love for the poor and the needy. Fr. Tony Mathew HGN will be here to preach about the missionary work of Herald of Good News on the weekend of May 3 & 4, 2025. Please support generously the second collection and take an active part in the work of Evangelization in the Third Millennium.

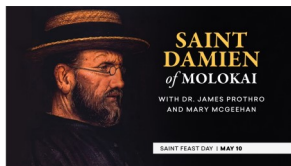

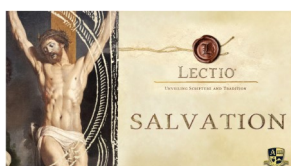
ST. DAMIEN OF MOLOKAI | CATHOLIC SAINTS
