Benediction at 7:00 pm

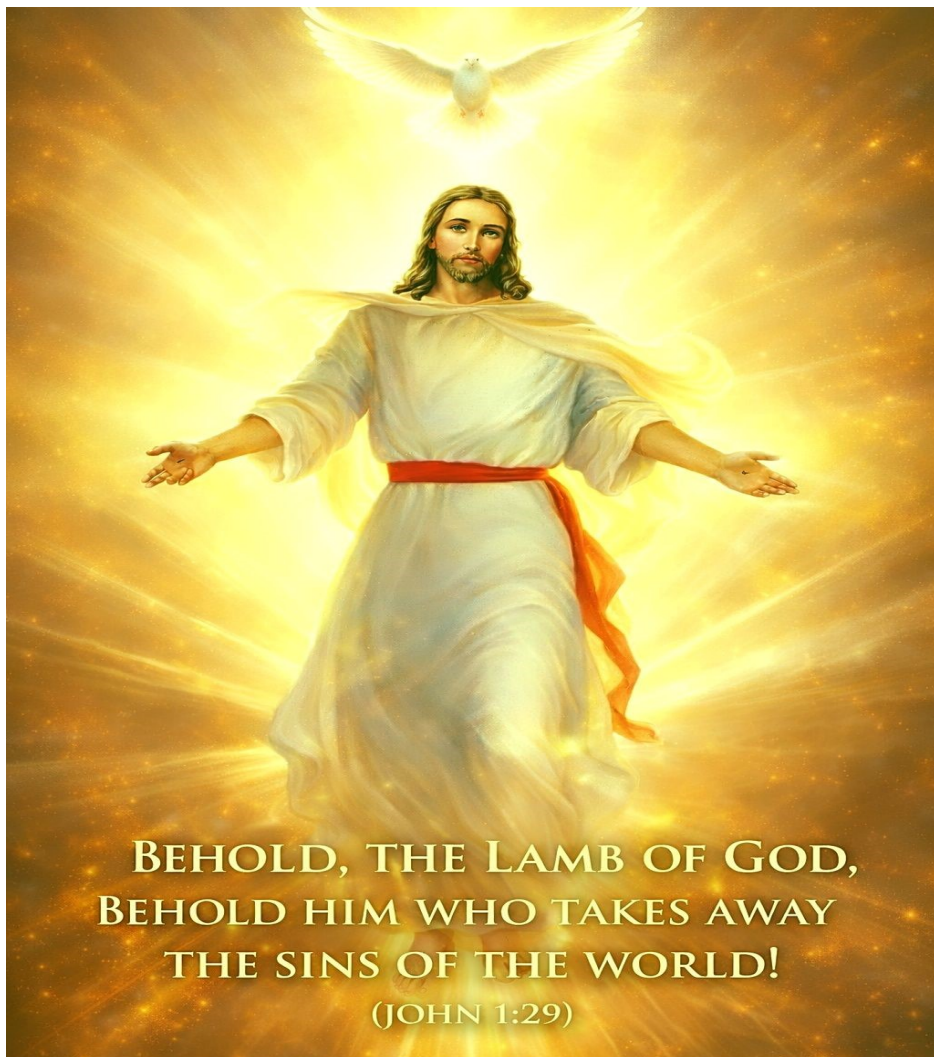

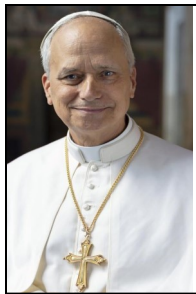
The guest preacher for this year's prayer service will be Rev. Dr. Nora Foust, Regional Conference Minister, Penn Central Conference, United Church of Christ.

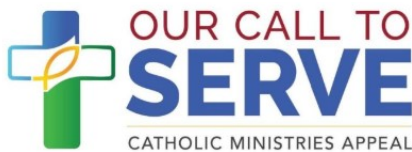
Thank you to everyone whose contributions of time, talent and treasure made it possible to keep Saint Michael Parish operating last year.

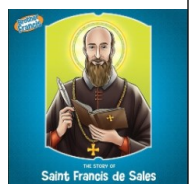
MARTYRDOM OF ST. AGNES | SACRED ART

St. Francis de Sales is the patron saint of writers and we celebrate his feast on January 24. Enjoy this short audio reflection for kids.



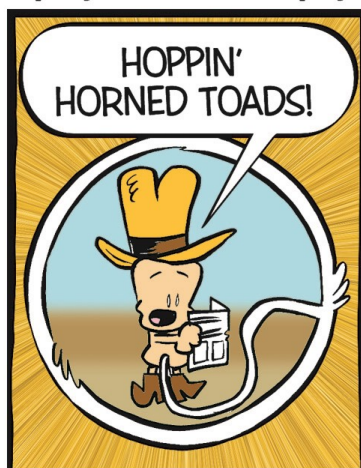
